



ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING & SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

25 January 2026 10:00 am via Zoom

Welcome and introductions.

The Association Secretary, Tony Glover, confirmed that the meeting was in quorum and welcomed members. The Chair, David Thomas, noted that the meeting would comprise the Annual General Meeting (AGM), followed immediately by a Special General Meeting (SGM) to approve the final steps of the transition to the registered charity.

Members were referred to the AGM/SGM pack and agenda circulated in advance of the meeting.

Chair's Annual Report (2025) and forward look to 2026

The Chair presented the Chair's Annual Report for 2025, highlighting key delivery activity during the year and the successful registration of UKATA as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation.

The Chair outlined the main priorities for 2026, including growing membership and volunteer capacity, strengthening communications and public storytelling, and delivering visible, high-quality national projects in collaboration with other organisations.

Treasurer's report and financial statement

The Treasurer, Andy Scott, presented the financial statement for the year ended 31 December 2025, summarising income, expenditure, and the year-end cash position.

The Treasurer confirmed the introduction of an annual membership fee of £12 for 2026 and explained how membership income supports the charity's activities. Members were also reminded that Gift Aid declarations should be completed where eligible to enable UKATA to claim Gift Aid on qualifying donations.

Membership and communications

The Secretary confirmed that existing members of the previous UKATA arrangements had been migrated into the charity membership system, and that renewal for 2026 is completed by payment of the £12 annual fee via MemberMojo and Stripe infrastructure.

The committee confirmed that the members that contact email address for enquiries is members@argentinetango.co.uk.

Voting and AGM resolutions

Voting was conducted by a show of hands in accordance with the meeting notice. The following AGM resolutions were put to members and carried:



- Resolution A: Approval of the minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 15 December 2024 as a true and accurate record.

The resolution was approved by majority of raised hands and carried.

- Resolution B: Receipt and adoption of the Annual Accounts of the UK Argentine Tango Association for the year ended 31 December 2025.

The resolution was approved by majority of raised hands and carried.

There were no AOB or questions on the forum.

Special General Meeting (SGM): dissolution and transfer of assets

The Chair closed the AGM and opened the SGM. The purpose of the SGM was to approve the dissolution of the unincorporated association and the transfer of its assets to the Charitable Incorporated Organisation (the UK Argentine Tango Association).

The following resolution was put to members and carried:

- Resolution: Dissolution of the unincorporated association and transfer of all assets to the UK Argentine Tango Association (Charitable Incorporated Organisation).

The resolution was approved by majority of raised hands and carried.

Officer changes

Tony Glover informed members that he was stepping down from the role of Secretary. It was confirmed that Koby Kulater would take up the role of Secretary for the charity going forward.

Any other business

Members raised a query regarding whether UKATA could offer an automated recurring payment option (for example, by direct debit) for the annual membership fee. The Treasurer confirmed that this would be explored.

Members were encouraged to join the UKATA Facebook group for project updates and ongoing activity.

There were no AOB or questions on the forum.
